Therefore, the AAA committee would like to inform you of the following decisions made for the start of the upcoming racing season:

- Mont-Farlagne ski race January 9-10; CMRC Junior Speed Camp January 28-29; Ski NB Speed Camp – February 1-3; and the Crabbe Mountain ski race - February 5-7 have been postponed.
- The Atlantic Cup will be cancelled for 2021.
- The AAA will not send any athletes or coaches to any National events in 2021 U14 Can Am's, U16 Eastern's and Whistler Cup.
