Race Rules	ACA and the spirit of the ICR. Protests in writing within 15 minutes after DSQ list is posted (Posted on Race Office door after each set of 2 runs). Protest fee is \$50. For the athletes' safety, all 999 participants need to attend both days of the Ski NB speed camp, unless they have attended an equivalent speed camp, in order to participate in the Derby. It is advised that all other athletes attend at least one day of the camp.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

All participants – athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and spectators must abide by the following guidelines of Crabbe Mountain. Please check the website for Covid Protocols <http://www.crabbemountain.com/safety/safety-risk-awareness/>

- Guests aged 12 and over will be required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccinations to access Crabbe Mountain and all facilities
