- SANCTION:** Ski NB, ACA
- DATES:** Saturday January 14 2023 & Sunday January 15, 2023
- ELIGIBILITY:** National Card holders: U16 (Ages 14-15), U18 (Ages 16-17)  
Men and Women
- RACE RULES:** ACA and the spirit of the ICR  
Protest in writing within 15 minutes of DSQ  
Protest fee is \$50  
DSQ list will be posted on MFRT Race Hut Door  
**Video evidence will be required**
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** All athletes planning to try out should have filled out the required Team NB CWG documents as communicated on December 5th
- ENTRY FEE:** Each athlete is responsible to purchase their lift tickets
- TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING:** January 13 at 7:00 PM at the Four Points Sheraton on Rice Street
- RESULTS:** Results for day 1 will be made available as soon as possible after the last races.
- TEAM ANNOUNCEMENT:** Sunday January 15 in the Bar at Mont Farlagne following tear down and compilation of final results.
- RACE FORMAT:** 3 runs morning, 3 runs afternoon if conditions allow
