Eligibility

- All the participants must be born in the year 2007/2008 and be members in good standing with their respective National Ski Federation. *
- Team Canada may select up to 3 Teams (9 girls/9 Boys). Selection is at the discretion of Alpine Canada Alpin. Seeding by coach discretion and WC Draw.

Entry deadline:

- Entries are to be submitted by the respective National ski federation or Provincial Sports Organization on FIS Entry Form ICR, Art. 215 by no later than March 25, 2023 by 5pm (PST time) and should include the following:
 - The participant's name, year of birth and competitor number.
 - Names and contact details of coaching staff who will be attending.
 - All area pass numbers for athletes and coaches (if applicable).
 - Please e-mail completed FIS Athlete Declaration forms.
 - Please email the attached athlete's bio (form available on website).
 - **ONLY ONE TEAM CAPTAIN PER PROVINCE/CLUB RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTRY / SEEDING AND PAYMENT.**

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Fees

- Entry fee is \$585 for athletes and \$480 for coaches, before March 25, 2023 (unless otherwise pre-arranged with race office).
- Entries received after March 25 will be \$635 for athletes, \$530 for coaches.
- Teams must be confirmed April 1, 2023 to avoid a \$50 change fee. This includes coaching staff.
- There is a \$50 cancellation fee for teams cancelling within 14 days of the event.
- There is a \$50 bib loss charge for all lost bibs.
- Payments will be made onsite upon arrival (credit card/cash/club cheques accepted/). An invoice will be sent prior to arrival for confirmation.
- Please see attached criteria for U16 teams.

The payment includes:

- 5-day lift ticket, valid April 12-16, 2023 inclusively.
- A meal package including all breakfasts and bag lunches from Thursday, April 13 through Sunday April 16, 2023.
- Helly Hansen souvenir jacket
- Dinners: Thursday Welcome Dinner, Friday Team Dinner and Saturday Banquet at the Fairmont Chateau Whistler.
- Race entry fee.

Rules

- The U16 events are governed by FIS rules and regulations. It is the responsibility of coaches and clubs to be familiar with the rules, particularly with regards to equipment and helmets: http://www.fis-ski.com/mm/Document/documentlibrary/Marketing/04/30/53/170614_CompetitionequipmentENG1718final_Neutral.pdf
- Helmets must be worn at all times by athletes, coaches and support staff.
- No smoking on any Whistler Blackcomb property.
- Teams will be put together at the Team Captain's meeting. There will be sheets available for sign up. There is a maximum of 6 per team (3 Ladies, 3 men). Athletes without a team are welcome to sign up as individuals through their coaches at the TC meeting, and will be assigned a team by the morning of the race.
- Teams will be seeded according to Whistler Cup Points as of Saturday, post races. Teams without seeding points will be seeded randomly in the draw. In the event of a bye in the first round, teams that would miss the first round may run the course during their bye.

Awards

- The Whistler Cup will be awarded to the best Nation in all 4 disciplines (SL, GS, SG and Team Event). Medals will be awarded to top 3 in each category/gender each day.
- There will be trophies for best performance by a Canadian male and female. Races counting towards these awards will be the SL, GS and SG. The Team Event does not count towards these trophies. Points will be awarded to Canadian athletes based on the World Cup points

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system. The top performing male over both disciplines will be awarded the Dave Murray Trophy, and the top performing female will receive the Nancy Greene Trophy. In the event of a tie, both athletes will be awarded the trophy.
