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Equipment	As per the Current FIS ICR & National Competition Rules for 2025-2026 Season
Volunteers:	Races depend fully on volunteers. An average of 1 volunteer per 3 racers is required to run safe and smooth race events. WSRC is asking each visiting club to provide volunteers. Sign up during Registration. Volunteers will be added to a chat group via WhatsApp – please monitor this for instructions. <i>Free lift ticket and lunch will be provided to volunteers.</i>
Parent Lift Passes:	We are not able to offer discounted lift tickets for non-racers this year. Tickets are available for purchase at regular price from the Ski Wentworth ticket window or in advance online. <i>Lift tickets can be purchased in advance online as the daily number of tickets is mandated by Ski Wentworth and is independent from WSRC.</i>

Race Office:	Race related business during the events will be communicated from the race office & directly to coaches via WhatsApp. (Schedule changes, start lists, DSQ lists, results, etc.). The Race Office will be located inside the Main Lodge in the Port Greville Room
